

# GETTING STARTED


Plug in your vaporizer.

Place on a firm surface away from combustibles. Glass/Ceramic Natural Mineral™ Heater CAUTION -- HOT!

Prepare your herbs by crumbling or grinding the larger pieces for optimal airflow.

Air Vents -- Keep Clear!



#### LOADING THE WHIP® HANDPIECE



Fill the Whip® Handpiece no more than 1/4 inch full, but with enough herbs to cover the screen.

Herbs should be well broken up, although stems and pieces may still be present.

TIP: You can suck the herbs up into the whip like a vacuum.



# INHALING THE VAPOR ESSENCE

Connect the Whip to the heater as shown (hands free only).

\*For Standard (non hands free) Whips, hold the Whip to the heater while you inhale.

Start drawing in full breaths of air.

The air in the tube should be clear as you draw.

While exhaling, you will experience a sweet herbal flavor and see a fine white mist.

After the first couple draws, disconnect the Whip and stir up the herbs with the bamboo skewer or packing tool.

#### HOW TO KNOW IF YOU ARE VAPORIZING CORRECTLY

Depending on the moisture content of the herbs and the temperature used, it is possible to get 10+ good inhales for any one packing. Temperature is affected by two things: the dial setting (clockwise is hotter) and the speed at which you inhale (slower is hotter).

After the first few inhales, remove the Whip to look at the herbs. They should only have a slightly toasted appearance. Depending on what you see, you may want to adjust the knob up or down, or draw the air in faster or slower.

Dark brown or charred appearance indicates excessive temperature - Draw the air in faster next time, and turn the knob down slightly. It will extend your herbs to use a lower temperature. If you do choose to keep the temperature high, we strongly recommend you stir the contents frequently.

No color change indicates low temperature - Turn the knob up slightly and try again, drawing the air slower to allow the air to gather more heat.

## HOW TO TELL WHEN YOU ARE DONE


You can tell you've completely vaporized your herbs when you get a popcorn or roasted flavor, and the herbs turn brown in color

Expel the herbs into a fireproof container by stirring up and blowing through the hose. Empty the container periodically.

## VAPORIZE WITH CAUTION!

Glass parts may become extremely hot during vaporizing. Read the warnings in detail on the back page of this manual.

Use essential oils in the Aromabulb only. Essential oils are far too concentrated to inhale directly from the Whip.

# USING YOUR VAPORBROTHERS® AROMABULB™ DIFFUSER (for your favorite aroma oils)

The Vaporbrothers' Aromabulb allows you to diffuse essential oils into an area of about 800 sq. ft., lasting from a few hours to an entire day, depending on how many oil drops you add. Please use only 100% pure therapeutic grade essential oil, and stay away from synthetic fragrances and "perfume oils." The Aromabulb works very well for all essential oils, including

HOW TO DIFFUSE OILS

Partially fill with distilled water and add a few drops of 100% essential oil. Slip the Aromabulb onto the heating element. Avoid spilling any liquids into vaporizer housing.


Turn your vaporizer on to its lowest setting (6 o'clock), and enjoy the aroma wafting through the room.

As the oil and water evaporates, feel free to add more. If the Aromabulb has dried out completely, turn the unit off and allow it to cool down before adding liquid,

## CAUTION!

The Aromabulb™ Oil Diffuser gets EXTREMELY HOT at the tube section that slips over the heating element. To minimize the risk of burns and breakage, allow the Aromabulb to cool down completely before handling.

Practice careful handling and avoid spillage of essential oils. Undiluted essential oils can burn the skin, eyes, or cause internal






Fireproof Container

#### CARING FOR YOUR VAPORIZER

#### Vaporizer body

Your Vaporbrothers® vaporizer will last a long time with proper care. Periodically inspect your vaporizer for damage, especially the cord and heating element. Don't let waste build up inside the wooden body of the vaporizer.

#### eewara

Handle all glass parts carefully to prevent breakage. Never tap the Aromabulb™ Diffuser or Whip® Handpiece against a hard surface. Replacement glass parts are available through your Vaporbrothers retailer.

## Cleaning the Whip® Handpiece

Keep the screen clean by occasionally taking a breath on your vaporizer while the Whip is empty. Clean the glass/ceramic parts by soaking in an alcohol solution or in boiling water. Clean the hose separately in warm water and mild soap. A Whip that contains a honey-colored residue will clean easily, while blackened residue indicates usage at too high a temperature and be harder to clean.

## Cleaning the Aromabulb™ Diffuser

Clean with alcohol or warm soapy water and allow to air-dry thoroughly before using.

# WHERE TO GET HELP? (continued)

If the vaporizer itself has developed a problem, perhaps from being damaged or just not working properly, we have a limited warranty that will get you back to vaporizing as soon as possible. Our warranty lasts the lifetime of the unit and applies to almost every conceivable problem you may have, with some notable exceptions: tampering or disassembly, sale by an unauthorized dealer, broken glass accessories, etc. The warranty is for mail-in service, and may incur a nominal charge for handling and return shipping. Registering your unit online gives you additional privileges. Full details are on the warranty certificate provided with your vaporizer.

#### IMPORTANT HEALTH AND SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS: PLEASE READ!

Electrical hazard, burn or fire risk, or exposure to broken glass may result from improper use!

The heat source and glass parts in this unit get EXTREMELY HOT and can cause instant burns. Keep away from children or prying hands. Do not let pets sniff the heater. To avoid fire hazard, keep away combustible materials or anything that could restrict the flow of air through the unit. Avoid placing your vaporizer on soft rugs, couches or other surfaces that block the bottom vents.

The glass pieces in the vaporizer kit can break into tiny fragments and cause injury. Never inhale through glass parts that are cracked or broken.

To reduce the risk of electric shock, keep your vaporizer away from moisture. Avoid operating your vaporizer next to a sink or while bathing. Immediately unplug the unit if objects or liquids fall inside, or if the unit is damaged. Please do not remove the bottom cover. There are no user serviceable parts inside, and tampered vaporizers are not covered under warranty.

Please use herbal blends responsibly. Know the published dosage and effects of your treatments. Many botanicals contain compounds that should be used only under the guidance of a health care professional.
